HISTORY

Table tennis in Alkmaar celebrates a succesful history! During the 1980's Hooge Huys (now Alkmaar '71) was one of the strongest clubs in Holland. The club had a strong link with English professional players with some players even coming to live in Alkmaar to play in the Eredivisie and in the European Cup.

With an extensive junior training programme table tennis in Alkmaar boomed in the club's beautiful fulltime venue. Over 500 spectators would be present to watch Hooghe Huys against their rivals Tempo Team (Amsterdam), which even made national TV!

Over recent times table tennis in Alkmaar has declined to recreational table tennis and is no longer benefiting from a fulltime venue.

In May 2018 Ping Pong Alkmaar was formed by a team of enthusiastic and ambitious people with the aim to get table tennis buzzing again in

Leading this ambitious initiative is Mark Smith, an English professional player/coach with a communityclub development background.

Supported by Alkmaar Sport and some local and international sponsors, as well as parents of the youth members and our volunteers, we set out to achieve a real difference for the sport and for Alkmaar.

Recently, multiple school clinics, public events, world record attempts and company masterclasses were delivered across Alkmaar which have created a brand new group of enthusiastic players, coaches and supporters.

New full-time accomodation

To create a **3-year new club accomodation campaign** working with key partners to secure a **new build table community centre.**

Junior academy

Expand the youth academy both at **GRASS ROOTS** and **TOP SPORT** levels. Further develop and encourage mixed level learning to allow beginners to improve at faster rates.

Implement **WORLD CLASS** training techniques developed by the leading world nations in table tennis.

Coaching & youth leadership education

Continue developing our comprehensive **work experience** programme for students to access.

Aims of this programme: Students delivering clinics, public exhibitions, event coordination and presentations.

Reaching out into the community

Developing Ping Pong Alkmaar as a truly inclusive club for everyone will involve increasing our outreach sessions further across Alkmaar town.

Building on already established sessions to bring table tennis to under-represented groups accross Alkmaar including people from refugee background, women and girls, homeless people, people with disabilities, senior citizens, mini-pingpongers (from 4 years old)

Top Sport & Professionalism

To continue developing a structured coaching and training programme to create a pathway from **beginner to exellence** available to **all ages.**

To encourage and welcome professional players from the Netherlands and **worldwide** to train and compete at the club and where possible play for the club.

Multi-activities

We already practice many different sports and activities with our juniors and plan to develop in this area further.

We have seen many benefits of **broadening our activities** including developing team work, improving cadio fitness levels and learning new transferable skills.



NEW CLUB FACILITY PLAN


To create a multi-functional community activity space specialising in table tennis. The facility design will allow different activities to take place in 3 or 4 seperate areas to maximise usage.




Canteen & social area - 8m by 9m
